HALLOWEEN CARNIVAL PTO PLANNING MEETING



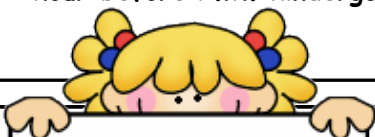

Soo Hill Top Dog Students of the Week



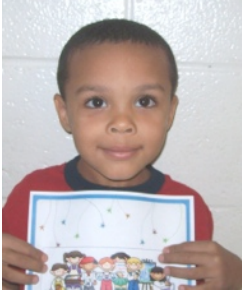
One student from each classroom was chosen as "Top Dog Classroom Student of the Week".

These students were chosen based on the following criteria:

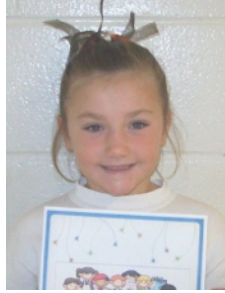
Student has made an effort to be respectful and helpful to his/her classmates. Student follows rules and directions from adults, and does schoolwork to the best of his/her ability.

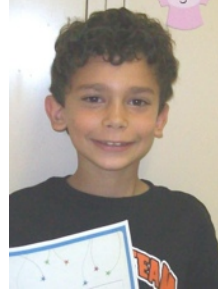

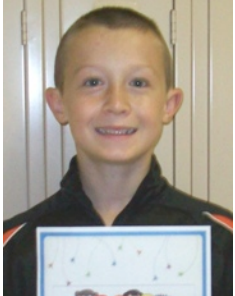
